



Address: 121 Hamilton Street

Date Constructed: 1890-1895

Date Designated: March 10th, 2009

Building Information: Located on the corner of Hamilton and George Street, the building features a corner turret with an octagonal cap. "Among New Richmond's best embodiments of frame Queen Anne residential architecture"¹ Other building features include stained glass windows, gable roofs and a Queen Anne Door at the east entrance. Building was utilized in the 1960's as a boarding house for school teachers who taught at the New Richmond School Building. Building is currently utilized as a private residence.
