Building Information: The building was originally constructed as a flour/grain mill and later utilized as a distillery and a lumber company. As a lumber company the building played an instrumental role in the rebuilding of New Richmond following the 1937 Flood. The building received major renovation in 2007/2008 and is currently occupied as a mixed use. 318 Sycamore Street is included on the Ohio Historic Inventory (CLE-488-10).
