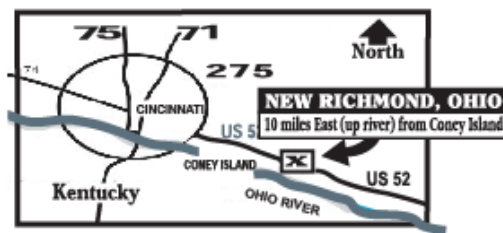
The artist will insure each work. Java Jazz'n Art members will employ all manner of careful handling and displaying to avoid damage.
