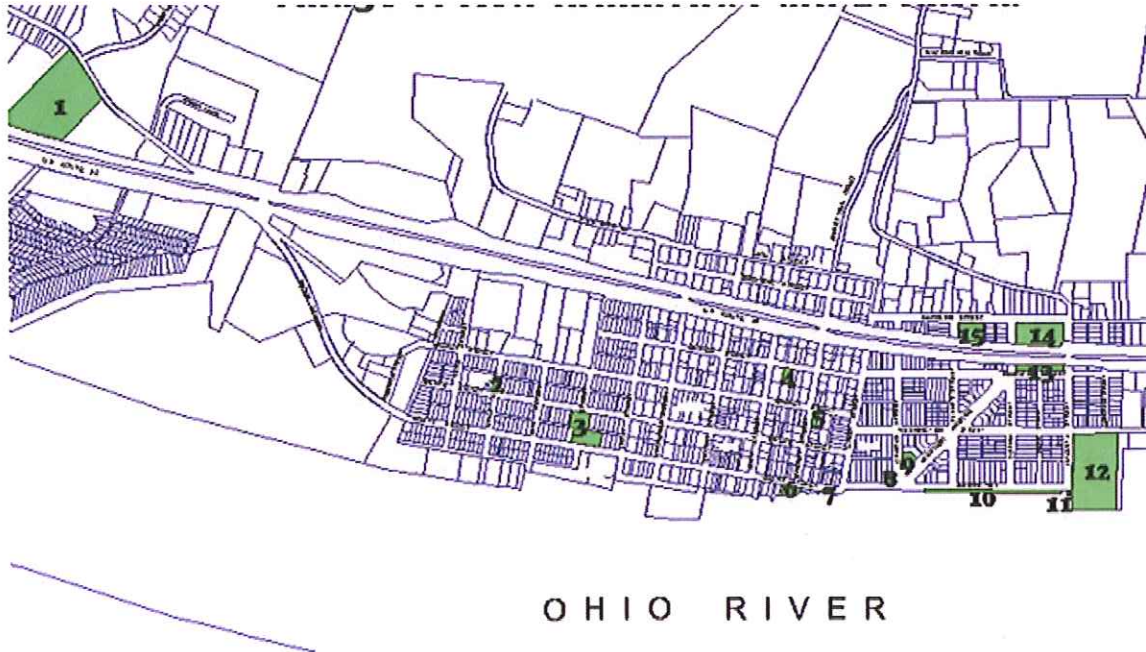


Village of NEW

The Village of New Richmond Parks and Recreation Commission is responsible for the maintenance of 15 parks within the Village of New Richmond. The quantity and quality of parks located in New Richmond are established for all residents in Clermont County. Enhancements continue to be made and new parks created. Newly completed park projects are the New Richmond Skate Park, Union Square Walking Trail and the Susanna Park Restroom Facility. Susanna Park will also serve as the terminus for the Ohio Rive Bike Trail in the future.

Village of New Richmond Park Locations



1. Ruben Franklin Willis Ball Field is located at 1029 Old U.S. 52. This park is 9 ½ acres that offers 4 ball diamonds, swing sets and off street parking.
2. New Richmond Skate Park is located on Race Street. This park is 1,000 sq. yards in surface area. The equipment includes wedge boxes, jump combo, quarter pipes, spine and grind rails.



3. George McMurchy Park is also known as the Plum Street Park. It is located between Front Street and Willow Street at Plum Street. This park offers a basketball court and playground equipment.



4. New Richmond Community Center is located at 212 Market Street. It offers off street parking and serves as the home for the Boys and Girls Club of Clermont County.
5. New Richmond Farmers Market is located at the corner of Market Street and Walnut Street. This site offers space for local produce growers.
6. Jessie Moonlight Haussermann Park is located at 201 Front Street. This park overlooks the Ohio River and offers a great view of the Kentucky Hills. You can also observe the flood gauge from this park.



7. The Overlook Deck is located in the 100 block of Front Street. This deck was made possible by cutting out a portion of the Wall. There are picnic tables at this location.

8. Thomas Ashburn Memorial Park is also known as The Bandstand. This outdoor theater is located at 116 Susanna Way. It serves as the home for the Village's annual concert series.



9. Susanna Park is located at 125 Western Ave. where Susanna Way, George Street and Western Ave. come to a point. This park is to serve as the terminus for the future Ohio River Bike Trail. The restroom facility is open to the public, weather permitting.



10. Captain Ernest Wagner Park is also known as the Promenade. This park is located along Susanna Way on the riverside. You will find several memorials, the Delta Queen air scoops, picnic tables and park benches in this park.

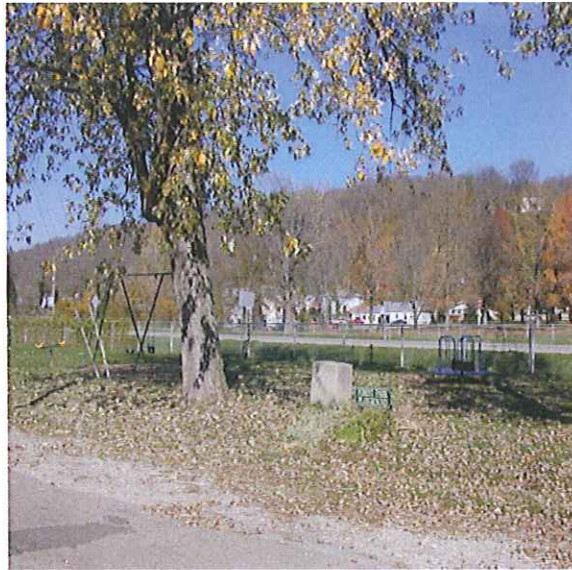
11. New Richmond Boat Ramp is located at the end of Augusta Street. This is a public boat ramp with on fee required and boat launch is at your own risk. Parking is adjacent at the J.H. Clasgens Ball Field.



12. J.H. Clasgens Ball Field is located at the corner of Washington Street and Augusta Street. There is a ball diamond and off street parking at this site.



13. Forest Park Playground is located at the corner of Hamilton Street and Augusta Street. This park has play equipment and basketball court.



14. Union Square Park is located at 509 Caroline Street. This park offers a shelter area, newly completed walking track, grills and an off street parking area. This park has become the host site for the Village's annual Day in the Park event.



15. Elm Park is located on Caroline Street. This park offers a basketball court and limited play equipment.
