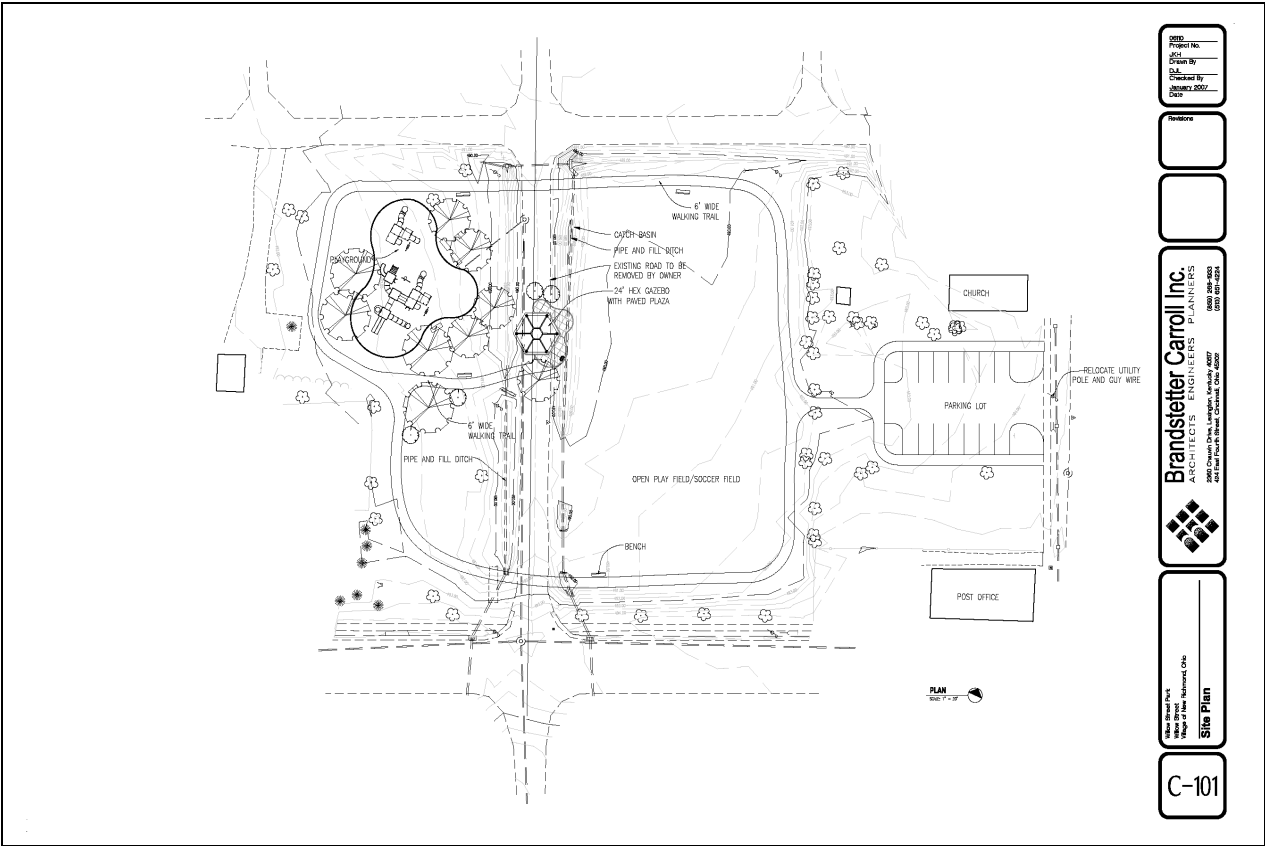

DESCRIPTION: The project includes the development of a new park adjacent to the post office along Sycamore Street. The park is constructed on land acquired by the village following the 1997 Ohio River flooding, utilizing federal hazard mitigation grant (HMGP) funding. The park includes a walking trail, play-set, gazebo and open field area.

The park is named after long time resident and former State Representative, Rose Vesper. The gazebo include in the park has been donated by Dr. Lee Vesper, former council member and husband to Rose Vesper. Funding for the park was secured thanks to the assistance of State Senator Tom Niehaus with a state capital budget pass through grant.
