The El Barril License Agreement has been signed by the mayor and owner and waiting on a copy of the required insurance, after received will need Scott signature at which time the agreement will be fully executed. The first-year payment has been made.

Well #4 which is our best producing well both quality (hardness) of the water and quantity, however we have lost 50% of the output due to the pump being worn. A new pump has been ordered and will be installed in the next week or two. Cost for pump removal, evaluation, new pump, and installation \$7600.

I have received an email from Steve Ferryman with Ohio EMA-Mitigation Branch regarding open space compliance issues. FEMA Hazard Mitigation Assistance funds were utilized to purchase properties in New Richmond and per the deed restrictions the property must be maintained as open space. During a resent assessment the following properties were noted to be out of compliance.

- 115 Washington Street trailer parked on property (Mr. Bowman)
- 219 Congress Street cherry picker parked on property (Mr. Jetter)
- 513 Center Street Construction debris in tree line (Mr. Scott)
