### **POLICE OFFICER - JOB VACANCY**

The Village of New Richmond, Clermont County, Ohio is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Police Officer, full-time and part-time.

The Village of New Richmond is an Ohio River community of 3,000 residents with 3.72 square miles of coverage. It is located approximately twenty miles south/east of the City of Cincinnati. The Village of New Richmond is the home of the largest Exempted School District within Clermont County.

The New Richmond Police Department is a smaller agency having four (4) full-time officers, and several part-time and auxiliary officers. However, we intend to increase our staff to better serve the community.

The selection process includes the following:

- Written Exam
- Physical Agility
- Oral Interview
- Background Investigation
- Psychological Evaluation
- Medical Screening.

Qualifications for exam:

- Must present a valid Ohio driver's license (must be at least 21 years of age).
- Must present proof of High School Diploma or GED.
- Proof of OPOTA certification.
- One year of enforcement affiliated.

Preferred qualifications:

- One year of enforcement affiliated.
- Secondary education (from accredited College/University).
- Military Service.

Required for additional education credit (will not exceed a total of 20% to a passing score):

1. Education credit:

- An additional 5% of an applicant's passing grade will be awarded, provided the applicant submits a copy of an Associate's Degree in a related field,
- Or 10% of an applicant's passing score will be awarded.

2. Military Service Credit:

- An additional 10% of an applicant's passing score will be awarded provided the applicant submits a copy of Form DD-214 showing an honorable discharge with the original application.
