

## ORDINANCE 2023-07

### VILLAGE OF NEW RICHMOND, OHIO

Council for the Village of New Richmond, Ohio met in regular session this 13th day of June, 2023 with the following members present:

Councilperson Allen moved for adoption of the following:

#### **AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FUND 2063, A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND WITHIN THE VILLAGE BUDGET, TO BE ENTITLED "OPWC WATER METER REPLACEMENT GRANT CJ09Z", AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of New Richmond desires to establish a fund to track the grant monies received and expended payments related to the Ohio Public Works Commission water meter replacement grant project.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the council of the Village of New Richmond, Clermont County, Ohio, at least three-fourths of its members concurring:

**Section 1.** That Council does hereby authorize and create Fund 2063, a Special Revenue Fund within the Village budget, entitled "OPWC Water Meter Replacement Grant CJ09Z".

**Section 2.** That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Ordinance were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 3.** That the Village by a  $\frac{3}{4}$  majority vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that the Ordinance be read on three separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of the Ordinance upon its first reading. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from the earliest date allowed by law.

**Section 4.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to approve this at the earliest possible time, to ensure that a fund is available for the receipt of monies in order to continue efficient fiscal operations of the Village. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all

members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

Councilperson Woodruff seconded the motion to adopt the foregoing Ordinance and upon roll call the vote was as follows:
