It is important that residents understand these meters have electronic wires and radios inside meter pits. Residents are **not** permitted to open meter pits to gain access to meter. Damage to equipment could occur and repairs made would be at the cost to the resident.

New Richmond resident, author, and Navy veteran Jim Serger has released his latest book on 9/11, in paperback form.

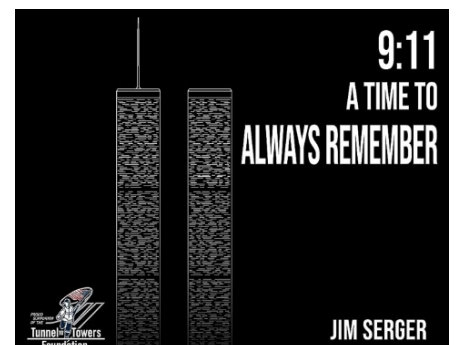
Several New Richmond residents share their personal memory of that tragic day. Over 90 photos, over 90 stories from folk's coast to coast.

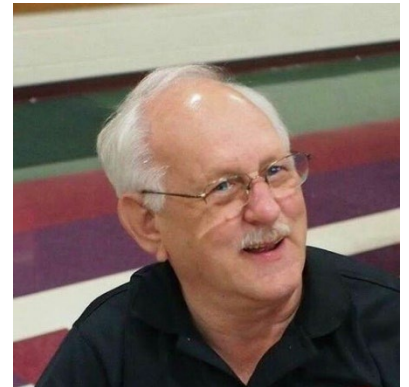
