Councilperson Vanderbosch moved for adoption of the following:

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER UP TO AND NO MORE THAN TWENTY FOUR THOUSAND TWENTY SIX DOLLARS (\$24,026) FROM THE WATER FUND #5101 TO THE WATER WELL DEBT FUND #5722, REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES**

**Whereas:** The Village maintains separate funds for the management of the Village and for performing all required tasks and duties of the Village,

**Whereas:** The Village maintains the amounts in these funds consistent with the annual appropriations, specifically adopted for 2017 via Ordinance 2017-02 and

**Whereas:** A previous reading incorrectly stated the amount to be transfer to the Water Well Debt Fund through the passage of Ordinance 2017-05

BE IT ORDAINED, by the council of the Village of New Richmond, Clermont County, Ohio, at least three-fourths of its members concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to transfer up to and NO MORE THAN Twenty Four Thousand Twenty Six Dollars (\$24,026) from the Water Fund #5101 to the Water Well Debt Fund #5722 during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2017.

SECTION 2. All conflicting ordinances or sections thereof , including , but not limited to Ordinance 2017-05, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from the earliest date allowed by law.
