Councilperson Feldkamp moved for adoption of the following:

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO SOLICITS BIDS FOR THE REPAVING OF THE LOWER SECTION OF BETHEL-NEW RICHMOND ROAD**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of New Richmond, Ohio, has determined that it would be in the best interests of the Village to pursue the possibilities and costs for the repaving of the lower section of Bethel-New Richmond Road located within the Village of New Richmond; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Administrator has been advised that the estimate to repave the lower section of Bethel-New Richmond Road located within the Village of New Richmond approximately 1,225 feet long will likely cost over fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000); and

**WHEREAS**, R.C. 731.141 requires that an expenditure which exceeds fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) shall first be authorized and directed by ordinance of the legislative authority of the village; and

**WHEREAS**, Brandstetter Carroll, Inc., has advised the Village that it will create bid packets with respect to the above-referenced project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of New Richmond believes that the repaving of the lower section of Bethel-New Richmond Road located within the Village of New Richmond will benefit the public's health, safety, and welfare as well as the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of New Richmond.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Council of the Village of New Richmond, Ohio, with 6 of its members concurring:

Section 1: The Village authorizes Brandstetter Carroll, Inc., to solicit bids for the repaving of the lower section of Bethel-New Richmond Road located within the Village of New Richmond.

Section 2: The instructs the Village Administrator and/or Brandstetter Carroll, Inc., to solicit bids for the above-referenced project in compliance with advertising, notice, and other requirements set forth in the Ohio Revised Code including, but not limited to: R.C. §§ 731.14; 731.141; and 731.15.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare of the residents of the Village of New Richmond. That the Village by a majority vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of the Resolution upon its first reading. That this Resolution shall be effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
