AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF VILLAGE EQUIPMENT

<u>WHEREAS</u>: Pursuant to sections 721.01 and 721.15(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Village of New Richmond has determined that the 2001 Dump Truck (VIN # 1FDAF57F51EA59197) with 8.5' snow-plow which has an estimated value of \$1,000 or more, is no longer needed for municipal purposes, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>: The Village of New Richmond has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Village to sell the aforementioned Dump Truck (VIN # 1FDAF57F51EA59197) with 8.5' snow-plow to the highest and best bidder; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to sections 721.01 and 721.15(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, selling the aforementioned Dump Truck (VIN # 1FDAF57F51EA59197) with 8.5' snow-plow required the Village to advertise the sale for not less than two nor more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in order to make a written contract with the highest and best bidder for an amount not less than \$1,500.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of New Richmond, State of Ohio with a majority of the members concurring:

- 1. Does hereby authorize the Village Administrator to advertise for sale of the 2001 Dump Truck for a minimum bid of \$2,500 and to make a written contract for the sale of the aforementioned Dump Truck (VIN #1FDAF57F51EA59197) with 8.5' snow-plow to the highest and best bidder.
- 2. Does hereby authorize the Village Administrator to right to reject any and all bids.
- 3. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of the Ordinance were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
