A Resolution Accepting an Annexation of 2.846 Acres

Whereas: A Petition for Annexation of 2.846 acres of land from Ohio Township into the Village of New Richmond was filed with the Clermont County Board of Commissioners by Scott Wolf, on July 9, 2014, and

Whereas: The petition is formally attached hereto and shown as exhibit "A", and

Whereas: An Ordinance Stating Services to be Provided to the Proposed Annexed Territory concerning this Petition for Annexation was adopted by the Village of New Richmond on August 12, 2014 and filed with the Clermont County Board of Commissioners on July 9, 2014, and

Whereas: The Petition for Annexation was adopted by the Clermont County Board of Commissioners on October 1, 2014 through Resolution Number 143-14 and delivered to the Village of New Richmond on October 3,

2014, and

Whereas: Ohio Revised Code section 709.04 requires that the village accept or reject the Petition for Annexation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of New Richmond, State of Ohio at least $\frac{3}{4}$ of the members concurring:

1. Does hereby accept the attached Petition for Annexation in the Matter of the Proposed Annexation of Territory Adjacent to the Village of New

Richmond in Clermont County, State of Ohio filed with the Clermont County Board of Commissioners on July 9, 2014.

2. That the territory included in the Petition for Annexation to be annexed into the Village shall be zoned "R-5" Multiple Family under the New Richmond Zoning Ordinance.
3. That Council finds that the Petition for Annexation along with the accompanying map or plat was placed in front of the Council by the Auditor or Clerk of the Village of New Richmond.
4. That Council finds that sixty days have passed since the delivery of the certified copies of the adoption of the Petition for Annexation by the Clermont County Board of Commissioners to the Village of New Richmond.
5. The Clerk of the Village of New Richmond is directed to make three copies of this resolution, to which shall be attached the petition, the map or plat accompanying the petition, a transcript of the proceedings of the board of county commissioners, and any other resolutions and ordinances in relation to the annexation, with a certificate to each copy that it is correct. Such certificate shall be signed by the auditor or clerk in the Clerk's official capacity, and shall be authenticated by the seal of the municipal corporation if there is any. The Clerk shall forthwith deliver one such copy to the county auditor and one such copy to the county recorder, who shall record it in the official records. The other copy shall be forwarded by the Clerk to the secretary of state.
6. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
