## RESOLUTION CREATING THE POLICE EVIDENCE ROOM CURRENCY FUND

Whereas: In performing its duties the Village of New Richmond Police Department obtains, holds, and safeguards monies and currency in its Evidence Room with respect to investigations, etc., and

<u>Whereas:</u> The Village of New Richmond Police Department believes establishing a fund to be established to receive and/or store said monies and currency from its Evidence Room until such monies are returned, forfeited, and/or legally disposed of would constitute a best practice policy for its department; and

**Whereas**: Establishing such Police Evidence Room Currency Fund is in the best interest of the Village and will help secure its safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of New Richmond.

**Now THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Village of New Richmond, State of Ohio with a majority of its council members concurring:

- 1. New Richmond Village Council creates the Police Evidence Room Currency Fund
- 2. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- 3. The resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare of the residents of the Village of New Richmond. That the Village by a majority vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of the Resolution upon its first reading. That this Resolution shall be effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
