A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE DURING CALENDAR YEAR 2023 OF MUNICIPALLY OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY WHICH IS NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, OR WHICH IS OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH IT WAS ACQUIRED, BY INTERNET AUCTION, PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 721.15(D)

WHEREAS, This Council is required to adopt a Resolution expressing its intent to sell municipally owned property by internet auction, including a description of how the auctions will be conducted, specifying the number of days for bidding, and stating the general terms and conditions of sale; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, after extensive research and due diligence, the Village Administrator is recommending Light-Gov, LLC at 100 DeBartolo Place, Suite 315, Boardman, Ohio 44512 as the Village's contracted representative to conduct auctions on its behalf; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, IT IS THE OPINION OF THE Village Administrator that said contract will benefit the health, safety, and welfare of the Village of New Richmond and its residents and property owners as well as help maximize the financial budget and resources available to the Village.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of New Richmond, State of Ohio with a majority of its members concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That during the calendar year 2023, municipally owned personal property which is not needed for public use, or which is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired may be sold at internet auction.

<u>Section 2.</u> That Light-Gov, LLC at 100 DeBartolo Place Suite 315 Boardman, Ohio 44512 is contracted as the Village's representative to conduct auctions on its behalf.

<u>Section 3.</u> Any such internet auction sales shall be conducted by way of <u>www.egovmarkets.com</u> internet auction services, pursuant to the rules and regulations promulgated and in effect for those sales organizations, however, the sales fees to be

paid by the Village of New Richmond to such internet services shall in no event exceed the amount of six (6%) percent of the accepted auction bid.

<u>Section 4.</u> That in connection with each such contemplated internet auction sale, bidding shall remain open for not less than fifteen (15) days, including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays.

Section 5. That in connection with each such contemplated internet auction sale, the terms of payment shall be cash, payment in full on or before the date of delivery to the successful bidder; further, the successful bidder shall be solely responsible for all acts and expenses associated with the delivery of such item(s) so purchased.

Section 6. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
