**A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT THE VILLAGE OF NEW RICHMOND
CLERK OF COUNCIL TO ATTEND PUBLIC RECORDS TRAINING
ON 9\16\16 AS DESIGNEE FOR THE MEMBERS OF VILLAGE
COUNCIL AND DECLARE AN EMERGENCY**

Whereas, All officials elected to statewide or local office are required to receive three hours of certified public record training for each term of office.

Whereas, If the elected official so chooses, the law allows a designee to be appointed to receive the training on the elected official's behalf. The designee must be an employee in the elected official's public office and there must be evidence of the designation. (Ohio Revised Code Sections 109.43 (A) (1), 149.43 (A) (12), and 149.011 (A)) .

Whereas, Acceptable evidence includes a resolution dated prior to the training that stipulates who is attending the certified public record training and if that person attending on his own behalf and/or on behalf of other elected officials in his office. Also, a certificate from the Attorney General or Auditor of State indicating that the person(s) registered for the training did , in fact, attend and receive the certification necessary.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of New Richmond, State of Ohio at least a majority of the members concurring:

1. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
2. This action is declared an emergency and passed as such because of the need to maintain the operations necessary to the preservation of public health, safety and welfare.
