Resolution Amending the Village of New Richmond Police Department Policy Manual to Include a Vehicles Pursuit Policy and a Portable Audio-Video Recorders Policy

WHEREAS, the Village of New Richmond has been advised by Interim Police Chief Couch that amendments, additions, and updates are necessary to be made to some of the current policies of the Village of New Richmond Police Department in order to bring such the department policies up to date with the current law and nationally recognized standards; and

WHEREAS, updating the Village of New Richmond Police Department Policy Manual to incorporate current law and nationally recognized standards will benefit the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of New Richmond; and

WHEREAS, Interim Police Chief Couch has proposed amendments, additions, and updates to be made to the Village of New Richmond Police Department Policy Manual by implementing and adding the proposed Vehicles Pursuit Policy identified as Section 307 and attached hereto as Exhibit “A”; and

WHEREAS, Interim Police Chief Couch has proposed amendments, additions, and updates to be made to the Village of New Richmond Police Department Policy Manual by implementing and adding the proposed Portable Audio-Video Recorders Policy identified as Section 425 and attached hereto as Exhibit “B”.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that New Richmond Village Council, with a majority of its members concurring:

1. The Village of New Richmond formally the Vehicle Pursuits Policy attached hereto as Exhibit “A” to be identified as Section 307 in the Village of New Richmond Police Department Policy Manual.
2. The Village of New Richmond formally the Portable Audio-Video Recorders Policy attached hereto as Exhibit “A” to be identified as Section 425 in the Village of New Richmond Police Department Policy Manual.

3. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
